DISPOSAL BAGS



Medication disposal systems are available at pharmacies, stores, and online. These bags use special chemicals to neutralize the medications. Simply activate with water.

Many different sizes from bags to buckets and larger systems are available for personal and organizational use. This is a very environmental friendly option for at home disposal.

OTHER OPTIONS

- 1 Mix medicines with an undesirable substance like dirt, kitty litter, or used coffee grounds.
- 2 Place the mixture in a container like a sealed plastic bag.
- 3 Throw the container away in your household trash. Remove any labels and personal information from subscription bottles.
